## THE PROCESS

1. Fill out the attached application form.
2. Turn in the application, along with any related renderings or drawings of your proposal, by:

  - Bringing it in person to Byron Taylor at the Greenville Chamber of Commerce.
  - Mailing it to Greenville Chamber of Commerce, P.O. Box 1055, Greenville, TX 75403-1055.
3. Finalists will be notified and invited to present their proposal to our Project Selection Committee.
4. The winning artist(s) will need to sign an agreement before the work begins. You can see a sample contract online at [HuntCountyPublicArt.com/samplecontract](http://HuntCountyPublicArt.com/samplecontract).

## THE TIMELINE

**Until Aug. 24, 2018:** Proposals for public artwork accepted.

**September 2018:** Finalists interviewed and winning projects chosen.

**October 2018 - February 2019:** Winning artists will help with fundraising and P.R.

**February 9, 2019:** Hearts for the Arts Gala will be held to raise funds for project(s).

**End of 2019:** Project expected to be completely finished and installed.

## THE CRITERIA

The Project Selection Committee will consider the following criteria when choosing a project to fund:

1. Overall visual and artistic impact to Hunt County.
2. Eliminating blight and urban decay from its chosen location.
3. Artist's track record, portfolio and experience in completing artwork..
4. Legwork that shows this project has a realistic chance of being completed in a professional, first-class way.
5. Financial viability and efficient use of funding.
